



- DIPLOMACY / MEETING: On 13/02, the GNU's Foreign Minister, Najla El-Mangoush, met with the Turkish Foreign Minister, Mevlüt Çavuşoğlu, in Ankara. El-Mangoush announced the GNU's donation of USD 50 million to Turkey, to relieve areas affected by the recent earthquake. She also announced that Libyan teams of rescuers will arrive in south Turkey to support ongoing relief operations.
- DIPLOMACY / MEETING: On 13/02, the head of the UNSMIL, Abdoulaye Bathily, met with the French Foreign Minister, Catherine Colonna. They discussed political and security developments in Libya, and the necessity to support a Libyan-Libyan process to facilitate inclusive and transparent elections in Libya in 2023. Bathily called for international stakeholders to unify their positions and speak as one to support elections.
- POLITICS / MEETING: On 13/02, the GNU's Prime Minister, Abdulhamid Dbeibah, met with the Chairman of the PC, Mohamed Menfi, in Tripoli. They discussed the executive steps needed to hold elections, the readiness and coordination with the HNEC, and discussed government spending for 2023.
- DIPLOMACY / MEETING: On 13/02, the French Ambassador to Libya, Mostafa Mihraje, met with the Head of the NOC, Farhat Bengdara. They discussed cooperation between the two countries in the field of oil and renewable energy.

TRIPOLITANIA

- Tripolitania, Msallata: On 13/02, 3 civilians, reportedly part of a car theft gang led by the mayor of Msallata, were arrested by the DAOCT, also known as Rada Special Deterrence Force, in Msallata.
- Tripolitania, Misrata, Al-Dafniya Gate: An individual was killed and 2 others were injured when clashes allegedly erupted on the evening of 13/02 at the Al-Dafniya Gate in Misrata, where a number of the GNU's Volcano of Anger Operations members have been stationed for 2 days, closing the gate in protest of the non-payment of their dues by the GNU. No further information available.
- Tripolitania, Nalut: On 13/02, a civilian was arrested by security forces in Nalut. He is accused of murder.

CYRENAICA

- Cyrenaica, Benghazi: In the morning of 14/02, 3 civilians were killed, and one was injured when a fire broke out in their house in Benghazi. The injured were transferred to hospital. Investigation is ongoing.
- Cyrenaica, Benghazi, Al-Wahaishi: In the early hours of 13/02, an exchange of fire was reported when a hideout of drug and liquor traffickers was raided by security forces and LNA forces during a security operation in Benghazi's Al-Wahaishi neighborhood.

FEZZAN

Fezzan, Sebha: On 13/02, a civilian was injured when unidentified gunmen opened fire on him in Sebha.
