## GENERAL SITUATION

- ✦ **HCS / DECLARATION:** On 18/02, the Head of the HCS, Khaled Al-Mashri, issued a statement on the sidelines of the 12th anniversary of the 17th of February Revolution, in which he promised that the elections will take place this year and no later than November. He affirmed that the constitutional draft will be completed quickly after solving few remaining obstacles.
- ✦ **DIPLOMACY / MEETING:** On 18/02, the GNU's Prime Minister, Abdulhamid Dbeibah, met with the Turkish President, Recep Tayyip Erdoğan, in Istanbul. Erdoğan expressed his gratitude for the Libyan help and praised the efforts of the Libyan support and emergency teams which have been sent to Turkey after the earthquake occurred. Dbeibah expressed his condolences to the Turkish people.
- ✦ **DIPLOMACY / MEETING:** On 18/02, the Vice-Chairman of the PC, Abdullah Al-Lafi, met with the Secretary-General of the UN, Antonio Guterres, on the sidelines of the AU Committee on Libya in Addis Ababa. Antonio Guterres praised the PC's efforts for national reconciliation and expressed his expectations for the PC to play a crucial role in leading Libya to elections.
- ✦ **DIPLOMACY / MEETING:** On 18/02, the Vice-Chairman of the PC, Abdullah Al-Lafi, met with the President of Central African Republic, Faustin-Archange Touadéra, on the sidelines of the AU Committee on Libya in Addis Ababa. They discussed bilateral relation, Libyan investments in Central African Republic and their protection.



## SECURITY SITUATION

### TRIPOLI

- ✦ Tripoli: On 18/02, a civilian was arrested by security forces during a security operation in Tripoli. He is accused of human trafficking.
- ✦ Tripoli: On 17/02, a DAOCT member, also known as Rada Special Deterrence Force, was killed by unknown perpetrators in Tripoli.

### TRIPOLITANIA

- ✦ Tripolitania, Gharyan: On 18/02, a civilian and a security forces member were killed by unidentified gunmen in Gharyan.

### CYRENAICA

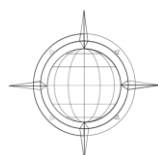
- ✦ Cyrenaica, Tobruk: On 18/02, a fugitive was arrested by security forces during a security operation in Tobruk. He is accused of armed robbery.
- ✦ Cyrenaica, Al-Jaghbug: On 18/02, a number of weapons, including missiles and bombs, were seized by security forces during a security operation in Al-Jaghbug. They were reportedly intended to be smuggled into Egypt.
- ✦ Cyrenaica, Benghazi, Gwarsha: On 18/02, 2 civilians were arrested, and 22,000 liters of fuel were seized by security forces during a security operation in Benghazi's Gwarsha neighborhood. They are accused of fuel smuggling.

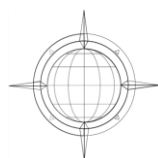
