GENERAL SITUATION

- ✦ **DIPLOMACY / MEETING:** On 22/02, the GNU's Prime Minister, Abdulhamid Dbeibah, met with the Qatari Ambassador to Libya, Khaled Al-Dosari, in Tripoli. They discussed Qatar's full support for holding elections in Libya and the GNU's cooperation with the HNEC to implement election with fair and impartial law.
- ✦ **DIPLOMACY / MEETING:** On 22/02, the GNU's Chief of Staff, Mohamed Al-Haddad, met with the Tunisian Ambassador to Libya, Asaad Al-Ajili, in Tripoli. They discussed the development of joint military cooperation between the two countries, especially in the maritime field.
- ✦ **DIPLOMACY / DECLARATION:** On 22/02, the Congolese Foreign Minister, Jean-Claude Gakosso, declared that AU mediation in Libya has begun to make an impact in Libya but will need further commitment from the Libyan people. He added that the AU High-Level Committee on Libya, chaired by Congolese President Denis Sassou Nguesso, will employ more professionals to ensure practical results on the ground.
- ✦ **DIPLOMACY / MEETING:** On 22/02, the Head of the UNSMIL, Abdoulaye Bathily, met with the Tunisian Foreign Minister, Nabil Ammar. They discussed Tunisia's support for a Libyan-Libyan solution that works for all parties to preserve Libya's territorial integrity. Bathily added that he has been working with parties inside and outside of Libya to promote its electoral process and praised Tunisia's support.

SECURITY SITUATION

TRIPOLI

- ✦ Tripoli, Ghut Shaal: A civilian was arrested by security forces during a security operation in western Tripoli's Ghut Shaal neighborhood on 22/02. He is accused of assault and armed robbery.
- ✦ Tripoli, Tripoli International Airport Road (south): 3 civilians were arrested and 1,590 tablets of drugs along with a quantity of cannabis were seized by security forces during a security operation on southern Tripoli's Tripoli International Airport Road on 22/02. They are accused of drug trafficking.

TRIPOLITANIA

- ✦ Tripolitania, Gharyan: On 22/02, a civilian was killed by an unidentified gunman in Gharyan. Investigation is ongoing.

CYRENAICA

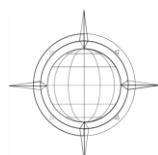
- ✦ Cyrenaica, Benghazi, Bohdema: On 22/02, a civilian was arrested by security forces during a security operation in Benghazi's Bohdema neighborhood. He is accused of assault, drug trafficking, and theft.

FEZZAN

- ✦ Fezzan, Ubari: 7 foreign nationals from African countries were reportedly arrested and a large quantity of cannabis was seized by LNA forces during a security operation near Ubari on 22/02. They are accused of drug trafficking.

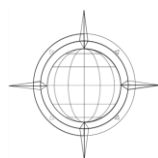
