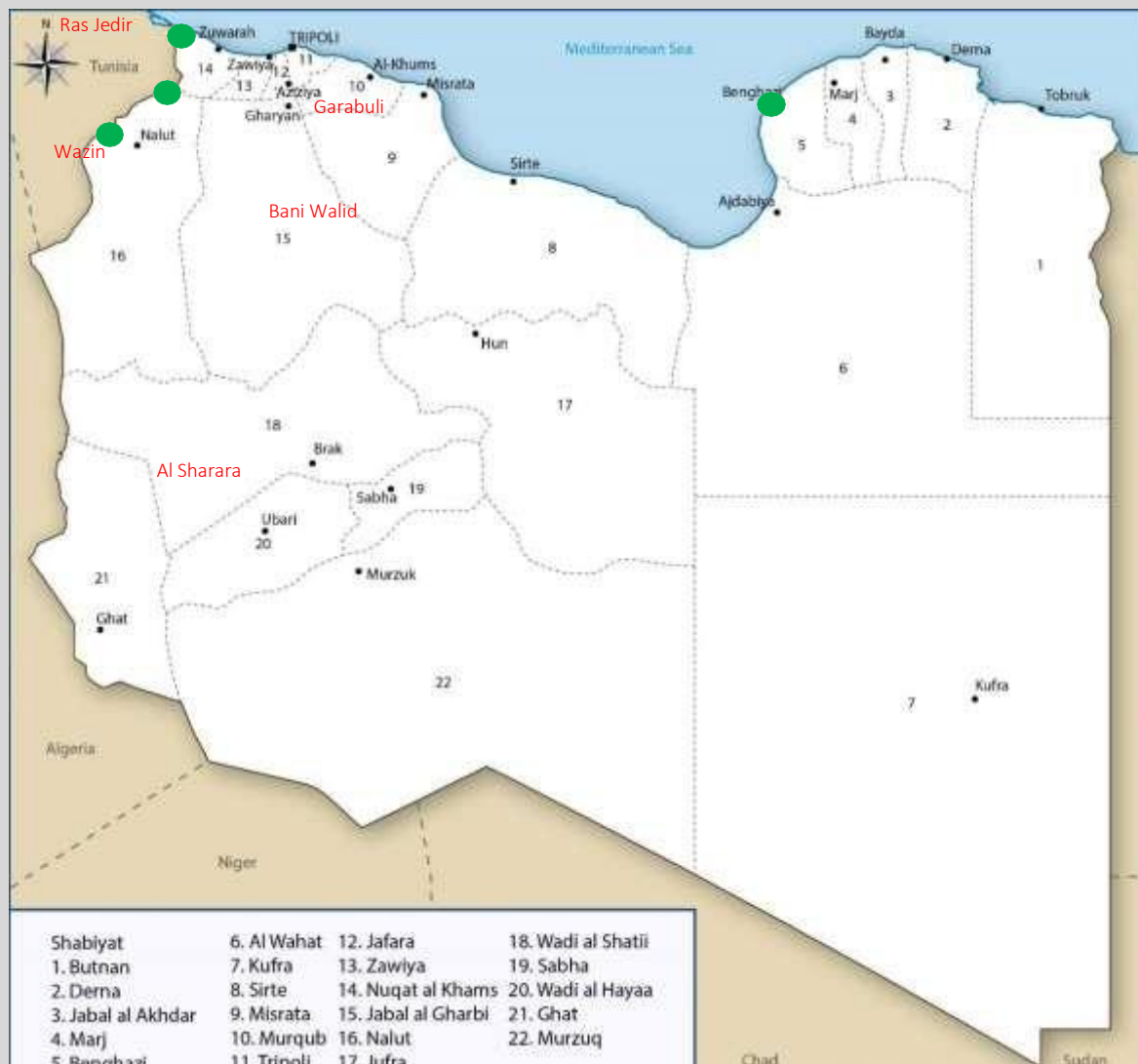

GENERAL SITUATION

- **IMMIGRATION CONFERENCE:** The Head of the Libyan Presidential Council, Mohammed Menfi, and Prime Minister Abdul Hamid Dbeibah will attend the International Conference on Development and Immigration, at the invitation of Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni, in Rome on Sunday. The attendance of Menfi and Dbeibah in the conference of the countries of the Mediterranean basin and the Middle East aims to strengthen efforts to stop illegal immigration influxes. The Italian government said the conference "seeks to help countries in Africa reduce motifs of immigration to Europe, adding that it will also focus on building partnerships for projects in different sectors including agriculture, infrastructure and health." It added that the conference "aims to control immigration, combat human trafficking, and promote economic development according to a new model of cooperation among countries.

Statement of Prime Minister Abdel Hamid Dbeiba:

- We do not accept the settlement of migrants in #Libya and we want to treat them well.
- Libya is a transit country for irregular migration.
- We want a radical solution to irregular migration and the repatriation of migrants in cooperation with the European Union.
- Libya can not deal with the migration file alone, and the world must take a serious stance to find a solution to this file.

Italy invited the General Commander of the Libyan National Army (LNA), Khalifa Haftar, to attend today's International Conference on Development and Migration in Rome, a Libyan diplomatic source tells The #Libya Update.

However, Haftar refused to attend due to the presence of Libyan Prime Minister Abdul Hamid Dbeibeh in the conference, adds the source.



- **POLITICS:** The Preparatory Committee for the comprehensive conference on national reconciliation in Congo-Brazzaville confirmed that the national reconciliation file will be accomplished with the participation of all Libyans without marginalization or exclusion.



At the conclusion of its preparatory meeting, the committee indicated that its mission is to prepare for holding an inclusive conference for all parties of the Libyan people, in order to achieve security and social peace in the country.

The committee indicated that it would conduct most of its meetings and work from inside Libya, applauding the commitment of the political, social and military leaders to participate after being invited by the African Union.

The Deputy Head of the Presidential Council, Abdullah Al-Lafi, announced from the Congolese capital, Brazzaville, the start of the work of the preparatory committee for the comprehensive conference on national reconciliation.

The Presidential Council launched last January the preparatory forum for the National Reconciliation Conference, which was hosted in Tripoli with the participation of representatives of the Libyan parties, Arab and regional stakeholders, as well as the Head of the African Union mission and the Congolese Minister of Foreign Affairs.



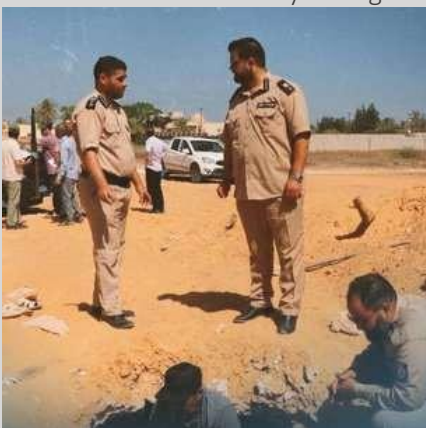
REGIONAL SITUATION

TRIPOLI

- Tripoli: The fire in the archives of the Courts Complex, Bab Bin Ghashir, burned and more than 5,000 files related to felonies and corruption cases were lost.
- Tripoli: Inspectors from the Food and Drug Control Center, accompanied by the Municipal Guard, launched an inspection campaign in food markets, which resulted in the seizure of a store inside the Carrefour market in Ain Zara that did not meet the necessary requirements and was closed.
- Tripoli: The PM of the unity government, Abdul Hamid al-Dabiba, announces the resumption of flights between Rome and Tripoli, starting tomorrow, Monday, after a ten-year hiatus.
- Tripoli: The Supreme Court in Tripoli ruled that the amendment passed by the Parliament in 2021 regarding the presidency of the Supreme Judicial Authority was unconstitutional. The law, which the department has deemed unconstitutional, is linked to the appointment of the head of the judicial inspectorate, Miftah al-Qawi, to head the Superior Council of the Judiciary.

TRIPOLITANIA

- Misrata: Electricity cut off in Misrata since 5 weeks ago , hours of darkness per day increased til 3 hours a day.
- Libyan-Tunisian Border: The national unity government announced on Saturday the conduct of patrols along the Libyan-Tunisian border strip between Ras Jedir and Wazin to prevent the entry of irregular migrants from Tunisia, except for vulnerable groups of women and children who are transported to the district headquarters and receive health care.
- Zawya: After a citizen bulldozed and surveyed his land in Al-Zawiya.. Tourist Police and Antiquities Protection Service found a cemetery dating back to Punic times.



CYRENAICA

- Benghazi: The “Kuwaifiya Police Station” of the Benghazi Security Directorate has launched campaigns against illegal immigrants under its jurisdiction and arrested a large number of expatriate workers who entered the country illegally.

- Ajdabiya: The Italian Embassy in Libya has announced the provision of support for the Man-made River Authority, at a value of 2 million euros, after the water pipeline blast in Ajdabiya.

- A Palestinian delegation to develop the Libyan health sector
The Minister of Health in charge of Dabaiba's government, Ramadan Abu Jinnah, met with a Palestinian delegation led by Palestinian Deputy Foreign Minister Ambassador Imad Al-Zuhairi.
The delegation underlined “the willingness of the Palestinian Ministry of Health to work in partnership and with the ministry and to exchange experiences, by sending specialized medical cadres to develop the Libyan health sector in the specialties of corneal transplantation, open-heart operations and open-heart surgery for children”.
It was agreed to “form a technical team between the two countries to identify priorities and agree on working mechanisms over the coming period”.
For his part, Abu Jinnah stressed Libya's commitment to the Palestinian cause, noting the depth of relations between the two brotherly countries.
- Partnership between Red Crescent and German Red Cross
The Secretary General of the Libyan Red Crescent has signed a partnership agreement with the German Red Cross, as part of the Society's policy to promote humanitarian action in Libya and support local communities
According to a statement posted by the Society on its Facebook page, this partnership is an important step that confirms the commitment of the Libyan Red Crescent to cooperate with National Societies to achieve common goals.
It also emphasizes opening up new horizons for development and strengthening the association's capacity to respond to humanitarian needs.
