Turkey's international relations

H.E. Mr. Mevlut Cavusoglu, Minister of Foreign Affairs, will pay a visit to Brussels on 20-22 January 2021 and hold talks with high-level officials of the European Council and the European Commission as well as the members of the European Parliament. Minister Cavusoglu will also meet with H.E. Ms. Sophie Wilmes, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs, European Affairs and Foreign Trade and the Federal Cultural Institutions of Belgium and H.E. Mr. Jens Stoltenberg, NATO Secretary-General to discuss bilateral and multilateral relations. During the talks in Brussels, all aspects of Turkey-EU relations, Turkey's accession process, current regional and international issues are expected to be discussed.
